

BALTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS – STAGE II

Competition Regulations

Purpose

To determine the winners of the 2026 Baltic Championships Stage II in the individual classifications of the Olympic shotgun disciplines Olympic Skeet and Olympic Trap.

Time, Venue and Programme

The Estonian Open Cup and Estonian Youth Championships will take place on **30–31 May 2026** at the **Elva Shooting Range** (61016, Uderna) as follows:

- **Open Category** – SKEET 125 + Final / TRAP 125 + Final

The Skeet event will be shot on two ranges using Matarelli machines.

The Trap event will be shot on one range using Nasta machines.

Competition Classes

- Men
- Women
- Juniors
- Seniors

Baltic Championships Stage II Schedule

30 May – starting at 10:00

- Trap and Skeet – 75 targets

31 May – starting at 10:00

- Trap and Skeet – 50 targets + Finals

Competition Rules

The competition will be conducted according to ISSF Rules.

Exceptions:

1. The new Trap final format will not be used. The Trap final will consist of 50 targets (25+5+5+5+10) using the standard Trap final format.
2. The new Skeet final format will be used.
3. No electronic timing system with scoreboard control will be used in the finals of either discipline.
4. Flash targets will be used in the finals.

Participants

The Baltic Championships Stage II is open to competitors from the Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian Shooting Federations, as well as guest competitors from other countries.

Team classification will be held in both Trap and Skeet.

- The top 6 shooters in Trap qualify for the final.
- The top 8 shooters in Skeet qualify for the final.

Officials

In both disciplines, each range will have a Chief Referee and one shooter acting as a side referee, appointed by the Chief Referee after the completion of each competition series.

Entry Fees

Baltic Championships Stage II entry fees:

- EUR 100
- Juniors and women – EUR 50

Fees must be paid by **28 May 2026** to the Estonian Shooting Federation bank account:

Alternatively, payment may be made to the Chief Referee on the morning of the first competition day by 09:30.

Organisation and Expenses

The organisational costs of the competition will be covered by the Estonian Shooting Federation.

Travel, accommodation, and catering expenses of competitors will not be compensated by the Estonian Shooting Federation.

Awards

The competitors placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the men's, women's, male junior, female junior and senior categories of the Baltic Championships Stage II will be awarded medals and diplomas.

Registration

Registration deadline: **28 May 2026**.

Late registrations may still participate by paying the entry fee to the Chief Referee on the morning of the first competition day by 09:30.
